

MARINE BIOLOGY WORKSHOP

Our workshops focus on routes into marine biology and also what careers are available to students wanting to study this field. We also look at the impact plastic pollution is having on the marine environment and work with students to come up with ideas to make a change in your school. We introduce the idea of eco-bricking and demonstrate ways to make your school more eco-friendly. Students will design campaigns which can be run throughout the year in their schools and will learn more about the opportunities we offer on our school trips to South Africa.
